

THE MESSENGERS OF THIS REFORMATION

The level of maturity of these messengers will depend on the flow of revelation that is available to them. The revelation that have been hidden in generations past can now be revealed to them as the Holy Spirit finds these vessels and qualify them to become custodians of the truth (*Ephesians 3:5*). These revelations of God are now revealed in the Spirit realm and it would require those who are living in the Spirit to have access to these truths.

The Holy Spirit must work deep inside their hearts to create space and increased capacity for these revealed truth (*Ephesians 3:7*). The life of holiness and yielded to God will then empower them to become the voice of reformation to the Church. They will discover the various levels of grace needed to not only be a custodian of truth but also a messenger of truth.

1. EXPERTS IN THE OLD, VOID OF THE NEW

Those men are experts in the Old Move and its truth not knowing the New. These men are fervent in the Old and for all that it stands for. They are cut off from the New but are faithful to what they know. Like Apollos, they herald the Old faithfully and fervently (*Acts 18:24-26*). It is because of their excitement and fervency that the Old remains in business though it may become obsolete. The Old Testament ministries still operate keeping the O.T. rituals, traditions and temple operations in service.

2. MOST OF THE OLD, LITTLE OF THE NEW

Those men have now come into the new message of Reformation but do not have full understanding and the depth of the restored truth being restored. They can only proclaim what they know presently. Like Apollos began to know a little more about Jesus. What he knew before was now expanded and contextualized (*Acts 18:25, 28*). His understanding of the New as well as its operational dynamics were not fully unfolded to him at this transition point.

3. EMPHASIS ON THE NEW, SEALING THE OLD

These men speak little about the Old but they emphasize the new message of Reformation. Their excitement and fervency of the Spirit is often contagious. They have discovered what is hidden and are now reveling in what has been unraveled to them (*Deuteronomy 29:29*). They find opportunity to communicate this to others. They find marketable means to reach as many with their new found revelations.

4. INTERPRETING THE RELEVANCE OF THE NEW

These preachers interpret the need for the New Message and how it is what we have been looking for. They create an awareness of the need now and how it will affect our lives and our future. The Old they say was only the shadow of things. The Old is like the scaffolding and its relevance has come to an end seeing that God is shaping a fresh new move. The building will continue to stand even after the scaffolding are drawn down. Now we have reached our opportune time, we can move in with the new (*Galatians 3:24*).

5. THE VOICE OF THE NEW IN THE LAND

These men are God's voice to herald a new beginning of a day that has broken forth. "Today when you hear His Voice." Every time the Voice of God is heard in the land, a new season manifest (*Song of Solomon 2:11-12*). A new beginning of life and abundance begins. The Lord is calling His people nearer and closer to Him. The messengers of the New exhort and inspire excitement into the hearts of the hearers. They rise to follow the new sound from heaven invading the house (*Acts 2:2, 6*).

6. MODELING THE NEW WITH CONVINCING PROOFS

These men develop the truth and dimensions of the new move and model them in their local church. Often the authority to preach above the new move and represent the new move is found in the ability to model it in the local community of believers.

The importance, the relevance and the impact of the new move is magnified if it is properly built into the grassroots of the church. Nothing means more to those who are looking for a new move in their church more than a working model in another church. This ground zero factor causes people to believe it is possible for it to happen in their locality. All things being equal; the results should manifest equally in both the environments!

7. PIONEERING AND GATHERING MOMENTUM IN NEW TERRITORIES

These men carry the truths and dimensions of the new move of God into new territories. They also carry the grace to break limiting conditions while making the waves into these regions. They also carry wisdom to bring acceptance for the emphasis of this new move. The local churches and ministers often provide the needed platform for momentum to gather strength in the territory. The Holy Spirit will allow Cornelius type connections who will become a beachhead for the New Move to stay accurately planted in that region. The word of the Lord will grow mightily and prevail when such favor is accorded on the ground.
